

# **DOING BUSINESS IN JAPAN 2017**

Doing Business In (DBI) is Djøf Students annual case competition and student trip organized in close cooperation with Novozymes and The Boston Consulting Group (BCG). In 2017 we will be traveling to Tokyo and Kyoto in Japan to do business. **And we want you to join us!** 

## The concept – what it's all about?

DBI gives 30 top-students from a broad range of disciplines and universities the opportunity to do real case-solving based on the business environment in Japan. Participants are challenged to move beyond their classroom knowledge and think outside the box.

The trip consists of two weeks around packed with cultural, social and business skill enhancing events and workshops. The trip begins in Tokyo, the largest metropolitan area in the world, learning about Novozymes and its current challenges/opportunities in Japan – followed by a stay in Kyoto. We will end our trip back in Tokyo where the 24-hour case will take place.

In the 24-hour case solving participants are challenged to work in groups solving a case based on a real business challenge for Novozymes. Representatives from both Novozymes and BCG will coach and support the participants during the case solving.
