

Volunteer Organizing Team - Doing Business in 2017

Would you like to get project management experience and work closely with Djøf, Novozymes, and The Boston Consulting Group?

Djøf is looking for new organizers to plan and coordinate a successful case competition for 30 fellow Djøf-members. Previous destinations have been China, India, USA and Brazil.

What is Doing Business in (DBI) 2017?

DBI is a case competition for Djøf-members from all across the country. The 30 participants will participate in a pre-seminar, where they will be equipped to solve a case, then a trip for 10-14 days where they will get a cultural input and the case to solve. The case is written by the organizing team in collaboration with the sponsors Novozymes and The Boston Consulting Group.

After the trip the groups of participants will meet at the finale where they will present their solutions and the winning team will be picked.

Your role as part of the Organizing Team

Your role as an organizer and Djøf-representative will be to tell the story of DBI 2017. It is important that, all members of Djøf hear about it and not only the 30 participants. You will also be part of a team that takes care of the logistical part of the planning as well as carrying out specific tasks. The tasks ahead will be both diverse and challenging and will require a structured approach and dedication. You should be prepared to have ongoing correspondence with the sponsoring companies, Novozymes and The Boston Consulting Group, and have strong social abilities in the contact with the participants and other important stakeholders.

The organizing team is responsible for:

- > Applying for scholarships
- > Marketing strategy, planning and execution
- > Organizing information meetings before the trip and screening of applicants
- > Ongoing status updates for the sponsoring companies
- > Preparation of case and accompanying case-material
- > Planning of logistics including local transport, flights, hotel, company visits and lectures

You are...

As a part of the organizing team you are committed to and engaged.

You have the following qualifications:

- > Interest in project-oriented work
- > Sense of responsibility for the assignment
- > You are a team player and prefer lifting loads as a group

Knowledge of case competitions and experience in event planning is a plus.

Your outcome

As a part of Djøf organizer team you give yourself and your fellow Djøf-members an opportunity to learn about the challenges of a Danish international company in a foreign environment. You will get a chance to build a strong relationship with Djøf, Novozymes, The Boston Consulting Group and the participants. You will get hands on experience with managing projects and processes. Finally, it is a unique way to experience a country from within.

The time required during the whole planning period will vary, but you must be prepared to spend a lot of time on DBI during certain periods. All in all this can be compared to an extra study job.
